# **ART EVENTS**

# 1. COLOR CLASH (WALL PAINTING)

#### **Guidelines:**

Participants can use acrylic, spray, or wall paints.
Only the provided area should be painted; no extra space can be used.
No offensive, political, or controversial artwork is allowed.
Participants should complete their work within the allotted time.

#### **Rules:**

No external pre-made designs or stencils are allowed.

Teams must bring their brushes, rollers, and colors.

Use of reference images is allowed but must be original work.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Creativity & Originality (30%)
Color Combination & Aesthetics (20%)
Theme Relevance (20%)
Technique & Detailing (20%)
Overall Presentation & Neatness (10%)

# 2. FACE PAINTING

### **Guidelines:**

Only non-toxic, skin-friendly paints should be used.
The painting must be completed within the given time limit.
Participants may work on a partner or use their own face.
The design should be visible and well-defined.

#### **Rules:**

No pre-made stickers or designs allowed.

Participants must bring their own face paints and brushes.

No external assistance is allowed.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Creativity & Innovation (30%)
Precision & Detailing (25%)
Relevance to the Theme (20%)
Color Combination & Aesthetics (15%)
Overall Impact (10%)



# 3. HENNA BLISS (MEHNDI)

#### **Guidelines:**

Participants must create designs on hands or arms.

No printed patterns or tracing is allowed.

The design must be completed within the given time.

## **Rules:**

No use of artificial or black henna.

The design must be freehand; stencils are not allowed.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Design Creativity & Uniqueness (30%)
Neatness & Precision (25%)
Detailing & Complexity (20%)
Theme Relevance (15%)
Color & Staining Quality (10%)

# 4. RANGOLI RADIANCE

#### **Guidelines:**

The design must be completed within the given time. Outlines can be done using chalk before starting. No external assistance or pre-made designs allowed.

# **Rules:**

No use of stencils or pre-drawn patterns.

Only the given space should be used.

Participants must bring their own colors and materials.

### **Judging Criteria:**

Creativity & Originality (30%)
Color Combination & Aesthetics (25%)
Symmetry & Neatness (20%)
Theme Relevance (15%)
Overall Presentation (10%)

# 5. T-SHIRT PAINTING

### **Guidelines:**

Only fabric paints, fabric markers, or tie-dye techniques are allowed. No pre-drawn designs or printed stickers are allowed.

The design should be completed within the given time.

#### **Rules:**

Participants must use their materials.

The design must be original; no copyrighted images.

No pre-stitched embellishments are allowed.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Creativity & Design Innovation (30%) Color Combination & Neatness (25%) Theme Relevance (20%) Painting Technique & Precision (15%) Overall Impact (10%)

# 6. MAKEOVER

#### **Guidelines:**

Participants must bring their own makeup and tools.
The makeover should be completed within the given time.
The look should align with the given theme.
Participants may use a model or work on themselves.

#### **Rules:**

Use of prosthetics or pre-made face masks is not allowed. The makeup should not be offensive or inappropriate. No professional assistance is allowed.

#### **Judging Criteria:**

Creativity & Transformation (30%)
Neatness & Blending (25%)
Theme Relevance (20%)
Color Combination & Aesthetics (15%)
Overall Presentation (10%)

# 7. SHUTTER MAGIC (PHOTOGRAPHY)

# **Guidelines:**

Participants may use DSLR, mobile phones.
The photograph should be taken within the competition timeframe.
Only minor editing (brightness, contrast, cropping) is allowed.
The subject should align with the theme.

#### **Rules:**

No use of pre-clicked images.

No excessive editing or use of AI-generated enhancements.

Participants must submit raw and edited images.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Creativity & Perspective (30%)
Composition & Framing (25%)
Theme Relevance (20%)
Editing & Presentation (15%)
Overall Impact (10%)

# **Literary Events**

# 1.CLASH OF MINDS (DEBATE)

### **Guidelines:**

The debate can be conducted in individual.

Topics will be given in advance or on the spot.

Each speaker gets 3-5 minutes to present their arguments.

A rebuttal round follows the main argument.

#### **Rules:**

No personal attacks or offensive language.

Participants must adhere to time limits.

Use of facts, statistics, and examples is encouraged.

The speaker must stay on topic; deviation will result in penalties.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Content & Research (30%) – Depth, accuracy, and relevance of arguments.

Delivery & Clarity (25%) – Confidence, fluency, and articulation.

Counterarguments (20%) – Strength of rebuttals and response to opponents.

Persuasiveness (15%) – Ability to convince the audience/judges.

Time Management (10%) – Adherence to time constraints.

# 1. JAM (JUST A MINUTE)

### **Guidelines:**

Participants must speak for 1 minute on a given topic.

No hesitation, repetition, or deviation is allowed.

The moderator will interrupt if any rule is broken.

If a mistake is identified, the turn passes to the next participant.

#### **Rules:**

No long pauses (more than 2 seconds).

No repeating words, phrases, or ideas.

No going off-topic; stay relevant to the given theme.

No external prompts or notes allowed.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Fluency & Spontaneity (30%) – Smooth, uninterrupted speech.
Relevance to Topic (25%) – Staying on track without deviation.
Clarity & Pronunciation (20%) – Clear speech and correct usage.
Confidence & Body Language (15%) – Poise and audience engagement.
Grammatical Accuracy (10%) – Correct grammar and sentence structure

# 2. SHORT STORY WRITING COMPETITION

#### **Guidelines:**

Word limit: 500-1000 words (varies based on the event). The story must have a clear beginning, middle, and end. Handwritten or typed submissions (as per event rules). Original work only; plagiarism leads to disqualification.

#### **Rules:**

The story must be completed within the time limit. Participants must stick to the given theme (if provided). No use of AI-generated content.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Creativity & Originality (30%) – Unique storyline and imaginative elements. Language & Writing Style (25%) – Grammar, vocabulary, and sentence flow. Plot & Structure (20%) – Logical sequence and engaging narrative. Character Development (15%) – Depth and relatability of characters. Emotional Impact (10%) – Ability to evoke emotions in the reader.

# 3. LAFZON KI MEHFIL (POETRY)

## **Guidelines:**

The poem can be rhyming or free verse.

Word limit: 12-30 lines (varies per event).

The poem should have a clear theme or message.

Original compositions only; plagiarism is strictly prohibited.

#### **Rules:**

Participants cannot exceed the given line limit.

No use of offensive or inappropriate language.

Typed or handwritten submission as per event rules.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Creativity & Originality (30%) – Unique ideas and poetic expression.

Language & Flow (25%) – Smooth transitions and rhythmic beauty.

Emotional Depth (20%) – Ability to touch the reader's emotions.

Theme Relevance (15%) – Connection to the assigned topic (if any).

Grammar & Structure (10%) – Correct spelling, punctuation, and format.

# 4. READ-A-THON COMPETITION

#### **Guidelines:**

Participants will read aloud a passage from a book/article. The passage can be pre-selected or chosen on the spot. Reading should be clear, expressive, and engaging.

#### **Rules:**

No skipping or summarizing; participants must read exactly as given. No use of mobile phones or external help while reading. Exceeding the time limit leads to deductions.

# **Judging Criteria:**

Pronunciation & Clarity (30%) – Correct articulation and speech clarity.

Fluency & Pace (25%) – Smooth reading without unnecessary pauses.

Expression & Modulation (20%) – Use of voice variations to add depth.

Comprehension (15%) – Understanding and correct emphasis.

Confidence & Eye Contact (10%) – Poise and engagement with the audience.

# **Judging Criteria**

Performances will be judged based on: Creativity and Clarity Audience Engagement Overall Impact

#### **Prizes and Certificates**

Certificates of Participation will be awarded to all participants.

Trophies and certificates will be awarded to winners and runners-up in each category.
