## General Guidelines for Participation in Cultural Performances Cultural Annual Fest - Sharda University Agra

## 1. Eligibility Criteria

- Participation is open to all current students of SUA/AECTC/SUGN/SGI.
- Participants must have a valid Student ID card.

## 2. Registration Process

- Participants must fill out the registration form and submit it before the deadline.
- Google Form Link: https://forms.gle/dPXDr8GkzHvcRMyW7
- For group performances, one member should be designated as the 'Team Leader' for coordination.
- Pay the registration fee as applicable.
- Fee Details:
  - Registration Fee: ₹150 (Includes participation in one event)
  - o Additional Events: ₹100 per extra event
  - **o Fee Calculation Examples:** 
    - o **Example 1:** Solo Dance  $\rightarrow$  ₹150
    - **Example 2:** Solo Singing + Solo Dance  $\rightarrow ₹150 + ₹100 = ₹250$
    - Example 3: Solo Dance + Duet Skit + Group Fashion Show → ₹150 + ₹100 + ₹100 = ₹350
    - **Example 4:** 4 events  $\rightarrow ₹150 + (3 \times ₹100) = ₹450$

## 3. Selection Process

- Screening auditions will be conducted to shortlist participants.
- Screening auditions will be judged based on creativity, presentation, and adherence to the category theme.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- If you are not selected in the screening round, the registration fee will not be refunded.

#### 4. Performance Guidelines

- Use of offensive language, derogatory remarks, or disrespectful content is strictly prohibited.
- Any act of obscenity will lead to disqualification.
- Props and costumes are allowed but should be pre-approved by the Cultural Committee.
- Participants should bring their own music tracks (if required) in a USB drive in MP3 format.
- Fashion Show will be conducted in evening & all the other events during daytime.

## 5. Rehearsals and Stage Setup

- Scheduled rehearsal slots will be allocated before the event.
- Participants must adhere to the allotted time slots.
- Stage setup requirements (e.g., mic, backdrop, props) should be communicated in advance.

## 6. Code of Conduct

- Participants are expected to maintain discipline and decorum throughout the event.
- Any form of misconduct, misbehaviour, or indiscipline will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Consumption of alcohol, tobacco, or any other intoxicants is strictly prohibited.

## 7. Judging Criteria

- Performances will be judged based on:
  - Creativity and Originality
  - o Presentation and Expression
  - o Coordination and Teamwork (for group performances)
  - Audience Engagement
  - Overall Impact

## 8. Prizes and Certificates

- Certificates of Participation will be awarded to all participants.
- Trophies and certificates will be awarded to winners and runners-up in each category.

## 9. Health and Safety Guidelines

- Participants are responsible for their own costumes, props, and equipment.
- Necessary safety measures should be taken to avoid injuries during performances.
- First-aid facilities will be available on the premises.

## **Rules for Cultural Events**

## 1. Groove Wars (Dance) Competitions

## 1.1. Soul Sync (Solo Dance):

## • Eligibility:

- o The competition is open to individual dancers only.
- o Dancers must register by the specified deadline.

#### Performance Time Limit:

- Each performance should not exceed the time limit of (3 mins).
- Exceeding the time limit may result in a penalty or disqualification.

#### Music:

- O Dancers must provide their own music and submit it in the specified format (e.g., MP3) before the competition.
- No explicit or inappropriate lyrics are allowed.
- O Dancers are responsible for checking that the correct track is played during their performance.

## • Dance Styles:

- All dance styles are allowed.
- Fusion of styles is allowed but must be performed in a family-friendly manner.
- Judges may score performances based on technique, creativity, and originality.

## • Costumes and Props:

- Costumes must be appropriate and should not contain any offensive or inappropriate elements.
- Props are allowed but must be safe to use and not damage the performance area.
- O Participants must take their props immediately after their performance.

#### • Rounds:

- Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- Final Round: Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 1.2. Mirror Moves (Duet Dance):

## • Eligibility:

- The competition is open to **Duo Dance Pair** only.
- o Dancers must register by the specified deadline.

## • Performance Time Limit:

- Each performance should not exceed the time limit of (3 mins).
- Exceeding the time limit may result in a penalty or disqualification.

## • Music:

- O Dancers must provide their own music and submit it in the specified format (e.g., MP3) before the competition.
- o No explicit or inappropriate lyrics are allowed.
- O Dancers are responsible for checking that the correct track is played during their performance.

## • Dance Styles:

- All dance styles are allowed.
- Fusion of styles is allowed but must be performed in a family-friendly manner.
- Judges may score performances based on technique, creativity, and originality.

## Costumes and Props:

- Costumes must be appropriate and should not contain any offensive or inappropriate elements.
- o Props are allowed but must be safe to use and not damage the performance area.
- Participants must take their props immediately after their performance.

## Rounds:

- Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- Final Round: Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 1.3. Echo Movers (Group Dance):

## • Eligibility:

- The competition is open to Group Dancers only
   (Min. Member: 4 Member & Max. Member: No Limit).
- o Dancers must register by the specified deadline.

## Performance Time Limit:

- Each performance should not exceed the time limit of (3 mins).
- Exceeding the time limit may result in a penalty or disqualification.

## • Music:

- O Dancers must provide their own music and submit it in the specified format (e.g., MP3) before the competition.
- O No explicit or inappropriate lyrics are allowed.
- O Dancers are responsible for checking that the correct track is played during their performance.

## • Dance Styles:

- All dance styles are allowed.
- o Fusion of styles is allowed but must be performed in a family-friendly manner.
- Judges may score performances based on technique, creativity, and originality.

## Costumes and Props:

- Costumes must be appropriate and should not contain any offensive or inappropriate elements.
- o Props are allowed but must be safe to use and not damage the performance area.
- Participants must take their props immediately after their performance.

#### Rounds:

- Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.

## 2. Star Voice (Singing Event) Competitions

## 2.1. Shine Solo (Solo Singing)

- Eligibility:
  - o The competition is open to individual Singers only.
  - o Singer must register by the specified deadline.

## Performance Time Limit:

- Each performance should not exceed the time limit of (3 mins).
- Exceeding the time limit may result in a penalty or disqualification.
- Language & Genre: Songs can be in any language, but inappropriate or offensive content is not allowed.
- Accompaniment: Participants may perform a cappella, with backing tracks, or with live instruments (if permitted).
- Mic & Stage Usage: Singers must stay within the stage boundaries and handle microphones properly.
- Judging Criteria:
  - o Vocal Quality & Pitch (Clarity, tone, control) − 20%
  - Expression & Stage Presence (Confidence, connection with audience) 20%
  - Song Selection (Appropriate for voice range and event) 20%
  - Rhythm & Timing (Proper tempo and coordination) 20%
  - Overall Impact (Creativity, energy, audience engagement) –
     20%

#### Rounds:

- Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- Final Round: Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 2.2. Duet Stars (Duet Singing)

- Eligibility:
  - The competition is open to Duo Singers Pairs only.
  - o Singer must register by the specified deadline.

## • Performance Time Limit:

- Each performance should not exceed the time limit of (3 mins).
- Exceeding the time limit may result in a penalty or disqualification.
- Language & Genre: Songs can be in any language, but inappropriate or offensive content is not allowed.
- Accompaniment: Participants may perform a cappella, with backing tracks, or with live instruments (if permitted).
- Mic & Stage Usage: Singers must stay within the stage boundaries and handle microphones properly.
- Judging Criteria:
  - Vocal Quality & Pitch (Clarity, tone, control) 20%
  - Expression & Stage Presence (Confidence, connection with audience) 20%
  - Song Selection (Appropriate for voice range and event) 20%
  - o **Rhythm & Timing** (Proper tempo and coordination) 20%
  - Overall Impact (Creativity, energy, audience engagement) 20%

#### Rounds:

- Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- Final Round: Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 2.3. Chorus Champions (Group Singing)

- Eligibility:
  - The competition is open to Group Singers only.
  - o Singer must register by the specified deadline.

## • Performance Time Limit:

- Each performance should not exceed the time limit of (3 mins).
- Exceeding the time limit may result in a penalty or disqualification.
- Language & Genre: Songs can be in any language, but inappropriate or offensive content is not allowed.
- Accompaniment: Participants may perform a cappella, with backing tracks, or with live instruments (if permitted).
- Mic & Stage Usage: Singers must stay within the stage boundaries and handle microphones properly.
- Judging Criteria:
  - Vocal Quality & Pitch (Clarity, tone, control) 20%
  - Expression & Stage Presence (Confidence, connection with audience) 20%
  - Song Selection (Appropriate for voice range and event) 20%
  - o **Rhythm & Timing** (Proper tempo and coordination) 20%
  - Overall Impact (Creativity, energy, audience engagement) 20%

#### • Rounds:

- Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- Final Round: Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 2.4. Lyrical Warfare (Rap)

- Eligibility:
  - The competition is open to individual Rappers only.
  - o Rappers must register by the specified deadline.
- **Time Limit:** Each participant has a set time limit (e.g., 2-3 minutes) to perform.
- No Profanity: No explicit language or profanity allowed.
- No Hate Speech: No hate speech or discriminatory language allowed.
- Respect Opponents: Participants must show respect to their opponents and the judges.
- Judging Criteria:
  - o Lyrics (25%): Creativity, originality, and impact of lyrics.
  - Flow (25%): Delivery, rhythm, and overall flow.
  - Stage Presence (25%): Confidence, energy, and audience engagement.
  - Originality (25%): Uniqueness and creativity of the performance.

#### Rounds:

- o Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- Final Round: Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 3. Acting Arena (Drama/ Skit/ Play)

## General Rules

- Team Composition: Each team must consist of 5 to 10 members, including actors, musicians, and supporting crew.
- Duration: The performance should last between 8 to 15 minutes, including setup and clearance time.
- Theme: The skit should be based on socially relevant topics such as gender equality, environmental conservation, mental health, corruption, etc.
- o Language: Performances can be in Hindi, English, or any regional language. Vulgar or offensive language is strictly prohibited.
- Props & Costumes: Teams must arrange their own costumes, props, and musical instruments. Minimal props are encouraged.
- o Background Music: Live music (dhol, tabla, etc.) and singing are encouraged. Pre-recorded music is not allowed.
- Venue: The event will take place in an auditorium.
- Team Identity: Teams must carry a banner or placard displaying their team's name or organization's name.

#### Performance Rules


- Entry & Exit: Teams must enter and exit the performance area within the given time slot.
- o Interaction with Audience: Teams are encouraged to engage with the audience during their performance.
- No Defamation: The script must not contain defamatory, communal, or political remarks.
- Avoid Dangerous Acts: The use of fire, water, sharp objects, or hazardous materials is prohibited.
- Respect for Time: Exceeding the time limit will result in penalties.

#### Judging Criteria

- O Performances will be judged based on the following criteria:
  - ✓ Content & Relevance to Theme-25%
  - ✓ Acting & Expressions-20%
  - ✓ Audience Engagement & Impact-20%
  - ✓ Creativity & Presentation-15%
  - ✓ Team Coordination-10%

### Penalties

- Time Violation: Exceeding time by 1 minutes − 1 mark deducted;
   exceedingly more than 2 minutes − 5 marks deducted.
- Inappropriate Content: Any content deemed offensive or inappropriate will result in immediate disqualification.
- Use of Prohibited Items: Using pre-recorded music, fire, water, or dangerous props will lead to 5 marks deduction.
- Failure to Maintain Discipline: Any misconduct by team members will lead to warning or disqualification based on severity.



## 4. Giggles Galore (Stand-up Comedy/ Mimicry)

## Key Features of Stand-Up Comedy:

- o Solo Performance: Usually performed by one person on stage.
- Jokes & Storytelling: Includes punch lines, anecdotes, and humorous takes on everyday life.
- Audience Interaction: Often involves engaging with the audience through questions or spontaneous reactions.
- o Timing & Delivery: Success depends on how well the comedian delivers jokes with precise timing.
- or unexpected moments.

## General Guidelines

- o Performances must be original, respectful, and suitable for a general audience.
- o Participants should adhere to the time limit specified (e.g., 5-10 minutes per performance).
- All performances must avoid offensive content, including but not limited to hate speech, discrimination, and explicit material.

## Mimicry Rules

- o Imitations should be accurate, entertaining, and in good taste.
- o Participants can mimic public figures, celebrities, or fictional characters but must avoid defamatory or offensive portrayals.
- Use of props, costumes, and voice modulation is allowed but must not disrupt the flow of the performance.
- o Avoid impersonating private individuals without their explicit consent.

### • Stand-up Comedy Rules

- Content must be original; plagiarism or copying another comedian's material is strictly prohibited.
- o Humour should be inclusive and avoid targeting individuals or communities in a derogatory manner.
- Participants may interact with the audience but must maintain a respectful and light-hearted tone.

## • Judging Criteria

Performances will be evaluated based on the following factors:

- o Originality (25%): Creativity and uniqueness of the content.
- o Delivery (25%): Clarity, timing, and stage presence.
- o Entertainment Value (25%): Ability to engage and amuse the audience.
- Tastefulness (25%): Adherence to respectful and appropriate humor.

## • Disqualification and Penalties

- o Failure to comply with the rules may result in disqualification.
- Offensive or inappropriate behavior may lead to immediate termination of the performance.
- o Any form of plagiarism will result in disqualification and potential barring from future participation.

## • Technical Support

- o Participants should submit any audio-visual requirements in advance.
- o Performances must fit within the allotted time, including any setup or teardown.

## Audience Interaction

- Light audience interaction is allowed but must be handled with professionalism.
- Any complaints from the audience regarding offensive material will be taken seriously and reviewed by the organizers.

## • Rounds:

- o Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- o Final Round: Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 5. Silent Expression (Mime)

## • Eligibility:

- The competition is open to individuals and groups (maximum 4 members per group).
- o Participants must register by the specified deadline.

#### • Performance Time Limit:

- Each performance should not exceed the time limit of (4 mins).
- Exceeding the time limit may result in a penalty or disqualification.

## • Performance Guidelines:

- No spoken words or vocal sounds are allowed, movements must convey the story.
- O Any form of explicit, inappropriate, or offensive content is strictly prohibited.

## • Judging Criteria

Performances will be evaluated based on the following factors:

- Performances based on Creativity (25%)
- Clarity of Expression (25%)
- Storytelling (25%)
- Stage Presence (25%)

## Costumes and Props:

- o Costumes must be appropriate and enhance the performance theme.
- Minimal props are allowed but must be handled safely and not damage the stage.
- Participants must clean up their props immediately after their performance.

#### Rounds:

- Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- o **Final Round:** Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 6. Style Symphony (Fashion Show)

#### General Guidelines:

- o The event is open to students from all departments.
- o Teams must consist of 10-15 participants.
- Each team must have a unique **theme and concept** for their fashion show.
- Outfits should be decent.
- O Use of vulgarity, offensive symbols, or inappropriate themes is strictly prohibited.

## Performance Rules:

- Time limit: 10 minutes per team (including entry, walk, and exit).
- Music tracks must be submitted in advance (MP3 format).
- Choreography should be **graceful and well-coordinated**; random or chaotic movement will lead to deductions.
- o Props are allowed but should be managed by the team without causing disruptions.
- Team members should maintain discipline and professionalism throughout the event.

## • Judging Criteria:

- o Theme execution (20%) Creativity and uniqueness of the concept.
- o Costume Design (20%) Innovation, detailing, and relevance to the theme.
- Ramp Walk & Confidence (20%) Poise, posture, and energy on stage.
- Synchronization & Coordination (20%) Flow of the performance and teamwork.
- Overall Impact (20%) Audience engagement, stage presence, and X-factor.

#### Disqualification & Penalties:

- Exceeding the time limit will result in **penalty points** (1 point deduction for every 30 seconds over time).
- Any inappropriate behavior, offensive gestures, or breaking college decorum will lead to immediate disqualification.

#### • Rounds:

- Screening Round: All registered participants will perform, and top scorers will proceed to the Final Round.
- o **Final Round:** Selected participants will compete, and finalists will be chosen.

## 7. Nukkad Express (Nukkad Natak/ Drama/ Skit/ Play)

## General Rules

- Team Composition: Each team must consist of 5 to 10 members, including actors, musicians, and supporting crew.
- Duration: The performance should last between 8 to 15 minutes, including setup and clearance time.
- Theme: The skit should be based on socially relevant topics such as gender equality, environmental conservation, mental health, corruption, etc.
- Language: Performances can be in Hindi, English, or any regional language. Vulgar or offensive language is strictly prohibited.
- Props & Costumes: Teams must arrange their own costumes, props, and musical instruments. Minimal props are encouraged.
- O Background Music: Live music (dhol, tabla, etc.) and singing are encouraged. Pre-recorded music is not allowed.
- Venue: The event will take place in an open public space (for Nukkad Natak) or an auditorium (for Drama/Skit).
- Team Identity: Teams must carry a banner or placard displaying their team's name or organization's name.

## Performance Rules


- o Entry & Exit: Teams must enter and exit the performance area within the given time slot.
- o **Interaction with Audience**: Nukkad Natak teams are encouraged to interact with the audience during their performance.
- No Defamation: The script must not contain defamatory, communal, or political remarks.
- Avoid Dangerous Acts: The use of fire, water, sharp objects, or hazardous materials is prohibited.
- Respect for Time: Exceeding the time limit will result in penalties.

## Judging Criteria

- O Performances will be judged based on the following criteria:
  - ✓ Content & Relevance to Theme-25%
  - ✓ Acting & Expressions-20%
  - ✓ Audience Engagement & Impact-20%
  - ✓ Creativity & Presentation-15%
  - ✓ Team Coordination-10%

#### Penalties

- Time Violation: Exceeding time by 1 minutes − 1 mark deducted;
   exceeding more than 2 minutes − 5 marks deducted.
- o **Inappropriate Content**: Any content deemed offensive or inappropriate will result in **immediate disqualification**.
- Use of Prohibited Items: Using pre-recorded music, fire, water, or dangerous props will lead to 5 marks deduction.
- Failure to Maintain Discipline: Any misconduct by team members will lead to warning or disqualification based on severity.



## **Faculty & Student Coordinator**
